**Gujarat
Home Guards
Act 1947.**

No.GG/49/2012/HGD/1099/3924/PT/F- In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (c) of section 8 of the Gujarat Home Guards Act, 1947, the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules, to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Head Constable Armourer Grade-II and Havaldar Armourer, Class III, under the subordinate services of the Home Guards Organization, Gujarat State namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Head Constable Armourer Grade-II and Havaldar Armourer, Class III, in the Home Guards Organization Recruitment Rules, 2012.
2. Appointment to the post of Head Constable Armourer Grade-II and Havaldar Armourer, Class III, under the Subordinate services of the Home Guards Organization shall be made either;
 - (a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the persons who;-
 - (i) have worked for not less than five years in the cadre of Armourer, Class III, under the Subordinate Services of the Home Guards Organization;
 - (ii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006;

- (iii) possess a valid light motor vehicle driving license on the date of promotion; and,
- (iv) have passed a physical efficiency test as may be prescribed by the Government:

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience specified in clause-(i) is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period, it may for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two-third of the period specified in clause (i),or

- (b) by temporary transfer on deputation from amongst the person working on the cadre of Assistant Sub Inspector (Armourer) Class III, in the subordinate services of the Director General and Inspector General of Police, Gujarat State, or
- (c) by direct selection.

3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall.

- (a) not be more than 46 years of age;
- (b) be a retired person not below the rank of Naik or Havaldar Armourer in the Indian Army or its equivalent rank in the Air force or the Navy;
- (c) have passed-
 - (i) the Indian Army Class I Certificate of Education or possess an equivalent qualification;

- (ii) the Electrical and Mechanical Engineering Trade Test, Class I (Armourer) or possess an equivalent qualification;
 - (iii) the Map Reading Standard-I Examination;
 - (d) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;
 - (e) possess a valid light motor vehicle driving license on the date of appointment;
 - (f) possess the minimum requisite standards of physique as specified in the Appendix-A appended to these rules; and
 - (g) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.
4. Notwithstanding anything contained in any rules, a candidate selected by direct recruitment under rule 3 shall be appointed on contractual basis for five years on the terms and conditions as prescribed by the Government Resolution Home Department No:HGD/1099/3924/P.F/F, dated:13/8 /2012.
5. The candidate appointed in accordance with rule 3 shall be given the prescribed pay scale of the post of Head Constable, Armourer, Graded-II and Havaldar Armourer, Class III after completion of contractual period, on his performance being found satisfactory during the stipulated period of service on contractual basis.
6. The candidate appointed in accordance with rule 3 shall, during the stipulated period of service on contractual basis, be required to pass the CCC examination for computer knowledge as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.

7. The candidate appointed in accordance with rule 3 shall, after regular appointment, be required to pass an examination of Hindi or Gujarati or both, in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
8. The candidate appointed in accordance with rule 3 shall have to undergo such training and pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.
9. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by Government.

Appendix A

Minimum Physical Standards for the post of Head Constable Grade-II and Havaldar Armourer Class-III. (Home Guards Organisation)

Norms to be taken in to consideration by the Medical Board.

(i)-A. For Male Candidates.

(ii)-B. For Female Candidates.

(iii) Candidates having any of the following physical defects shall not be fit for the post, namely:-

(i) Knock knee (ii) pigeon Chest (iii) Squint Eye (iv) Flat Feet (v) Varicose Veins, (vi) Hammer Tees (vii) Fractured Limb (viii) Decayed Teeth (ix) Communicable (x) Skin Disease.

(iv) The medical officers shall examine the candidate shall issue the certificate of fitness taking into consideration Physical standard as mentioned above and also certify for the following matter, namely:-
