CONSTITUTION  
OF INDIA

No. GG/16/2010/MKM/102007/267(PT-V)E-1:- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating the recruitment to the post of Administrative Officer of Prohibition and Excise Class-I, in General State Service of the Prohibition and Excise Department, namely:-

1 These rules may be called the Administrative Officer of Prohibition and Excise, Class-I Recruitment Rules, 2010 .

2 Appointment to the post of Administrative Officer of Prohibition and Excise, Class-I shall be made either

(a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the persons who-

(i) have worked for not less than eight years in the cadre of Assistant Director of Prohibition and Excise Class II and

(ii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006:

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience as specified in sub clause (i) above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period: it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two thirds of the period specified in sub clause (i) above; or,

(b) by direct selection.

3 To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2,

a candidate shall, -

(a) not be more than 33 years of age;

(b) possess

(i) a second class degree obtained from any of the Universities or institutions established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognized as such or declared as deemed University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; or possesses an equivalent qualification recognized by the Government.

(ii) the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;

(c) have atleast 5 years administrative experience on a post not lower than Office Superintendent or equivalent, under the State or Central Government or a post in private or joint sector or Government undertaking which can be treated equivalent to Office Superintendent considering the pay scale, duties and responsibilities;

(d) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati and or/ Hindi:


Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967.

4 The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.

5 The candidate appointed by direct selection shall during his probation period be required to undergo pre-service training and to pass the post training examination in accordance with the Gazetted Officers Pre-Service Training and Examination Rules, 1970.

- 6 The candidate appointed by direct selection shall during his probation period be required to pass the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006
- 7 The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to pass an examination in Hindi or Gujarati or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
- 8 The candidate appointed either by promotion or by direct selection shall have to undergo such training and pass post training examination in accordance with the rules as may be prescribed by the Government.
- 9 The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish a security and surety bonds in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.
